#### 2. Report back - Annual General Meting, 09.11.2019

#### **Untried Bench Tips**

Denture Cleaner is useful for cleaning the insides of geodes – no more scrubbing und bubbling. The geodes will sparkle like diamonds.

When working with a soft stone such as onyx or marble, soak it in water for a couple of days before cutting. This will keep oil from soaking in and discolour the stone and will also result in a higher polish.

#### 7. Early Announcement: Collection Outing – Groot Marico, 21 – 23 February 2020

We will be leaving on Saturday morning, February 22, at 08:00 from the farm for the Witkop Fluorspar Mine to collect e.g. pyrite, tremolite needle crystals, calcite, manganese oxide, sphalerite and galena.

According to the Mine's Act each person must wear safety (sturdy) shoes, a hard hat and a reflective vest. Please bring along as the mine does not supply any.

Goethite (Limonite pseudo pyrite) will also be collected this weekend as well as agates, carnelians and autumn coloured slate.

We will camp on the farm, Kaaloog,  $(25^{\circ}48'09.2"$  **S**  $26^{\circ}21'56.6"$  **E**) of David and Diana Reyneke. This was previously the farm of the late Hannes Palm. Swimming is possible so bring along your gear. Bring and braais will be held in the evenings.

1.1 Rooms at R250,00 pppd. These are available at the main house. Linen will be provided.

1.2 Camping and caravaning at R100,00 pppd. Power is included. Bring along an extension cord.
